Online Banking

If you have not already done so, please sign up for online banking.

1. Go to www.westsidebank.net
2. In the top right, you will see the Online Banking portal. Select the “Enroll” button.
3. Complete the three steps with the requested personal information and submit your enrollment

Mobile App

AFTER you are enrolled in Online Banking, you may utilize the Mobile App.

1. Login to your online banking account.
2. Select “Self Service” Tab on the top navigation and scroll down to select “Account Maintenance.”
3. Select “Mobile Banking” at the top underneath the “Account Maintenance” Heading.
4. Follow steps to enroll your mobile device on the online banking system.
5. Once your device is enrolled via Online Banking, You can download the Westside Bank Mobile App from your App Store or on Google Play. Search for “**Westside Bank Mobile**” and install it on your phone or device. Follow the steps to link it to your account.

Deposit Checks

You are able to deposit checks via the Westside Bank Mobile App. Please read restrictions concerning daily limits in the app instructions.

1. Open the App and sign-in.
2. Select the “+” button on the bottom center of the app.
3. Select “Deposit” on the right.
4. Follow the instructions to take a picture of the front and back of your endorsed check. **PLEASE NOTE:** You will need to sign and write “*For Mobile Deposit Only at Westside Bank*” on the back.

Transfer Funds

Once you have enrolled in online banking, you can transfer funds between your Westside Bank accounts online.

Bill Payment

Use online or mobile banking to pay your bills automatically from the system.

Withdraw Cash and/or Checks

With your Westside Bank ATM / debit card, you may make withdrawals at either of our branches or at any ATM machine bearing the Star and/or Cirrus logo at no charge.
